Ukraine Appeal for Donations - Update

The Ukraine Centre at 2A Fosse Road South, LE3 0QD are appealing for the following items. If you are able to kindly help in this, items may be delivered to the "Ukraine donations box" at the back of the church, or if possible these can be delivered to the Ukraine Centre directly (they only open on Friday evenings 7-9pm).

Items they are in need of are:-

Medical - medicines, medical aids and equipment, first aid kits, dressings, catheters, glasses, incontinence pads, crutches, walking aids etc.

Food - pasta, rice, noodles, cup-a-soups, tinned foods - meat, fish, vegetables, soup etc. Sweets, chocolate, biscuits, tea, coffee, hot chocolate, drinks, baby food and milk, cereals, non-perishable goods etc.

Toiletries - toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, shampoo, shower gel, deodorant, baby wipes, sanitary products, nappies etc.

Other - sleeping bags, tents, blankets, duvets, bedding, towels, torches, batteries, clothing, hats, gloves, footwear, toys etc.
