

Saint James, son of Zebedee (died 44 AD) was one of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus. He was a son of Zebedee and Salome, and brother of John the Apostle. He is also called James the Greater to distinguish him from James, son of Alphaeus, who is also known as James the Lesser.

Saint James is the Patron Saint of Spain and according

to legend, his remains are held in Santiago de Compostela in Galicia (Spain).

Feast Day: 25th July



Saint Nicholas was a historic 4th-century saint and Greek Bishop of Myra (modern-day Turkey). Because of the many miracles attributed to his intercession, he is also known as Nikolaos the Wonderworker. He had a reputation for secret gift-giving, such as putting coins in the shoes of those who left them out for him, and thus became the model for Santa Claus, whose modern name comes from the Dutch Sinterklaas. In 1087, his relics were furtively translated to Bari, in south eastern Italy.

Saint Nicholas is the patron saint of sailors, merchants, archers, thieves, children, and students.

The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin: May 31st.


The feast of the St. Mary the Virgin is observed on the traditional day of the Assumption, Aug 15th.
