CHRISTMAS APPEAL 2024

2024 is the 50th anniversary of the setting up of SHARP as an independent local charity. We continue to help those who are homeless, at risk of becoming homeless or living in poor housing conditions in Leicester and Leicestershire. Our services are unfortunately needed more now than ever. 2024 has seen the problems of homelessness escalate astronomically. In the summer, there were over 500 homeless families (including nearly 1,000 children) and more than 150 single people having to live in temporary accommodation in Leicester because there was no housing available for them. These are levels not seen for decades. It means that so many families with children are having to live in one room which is totally unacceptable. The number of people turning to SHARP for help has doubled in the last three years and there has been a huge increase in the number living in very poor housing conditions.

We have recently carried out some research using data about our clients which tells us a lot about the nature and extent of the problems they are facing. A copy of this research can be found on our website www.leicestershelter.org.uk

SHARP remains fully committed to Leicester's Homelessness Charter. Our services are free. Originally, we were funded in part by Shelter nationally. We still maintain links with Shelter but no longer receive any funding from them. We receive no financial support from Leicester City Council or any local authorities. We do receive some core funding from the National Lottery but to meet current needs, we must also fund raise via donations from individuals, businesses and other organisations such as churches.

We know many churches have supported SHARP in the past and we are very grateful for this. We are asking if your Church will provide financial support for SHARP this Christmas.
